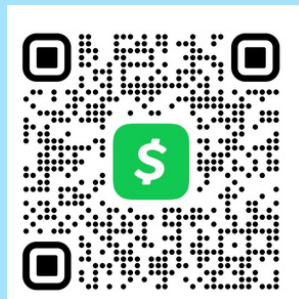

Tiny Miss: Ages 3 to 6, AUS will host the Pearl Princess Camp Saturday July 25 at High Point Theatre. Participants will receive a sash; stage presentation session and party with our AUS Tiny Miss, Jr. Miss, Teen, and Miss Queens; On-Stage Introduction at the AUS Pageant Finale Show; Photogenic winner will be announced and will receive the AUS Mini Crown. Camp cost is \$100 and does not require overnight stay. Wardrobe needed will be a short dress of cocktail style or Sunday dress for stage; cute outfit for stage presentation session and party.

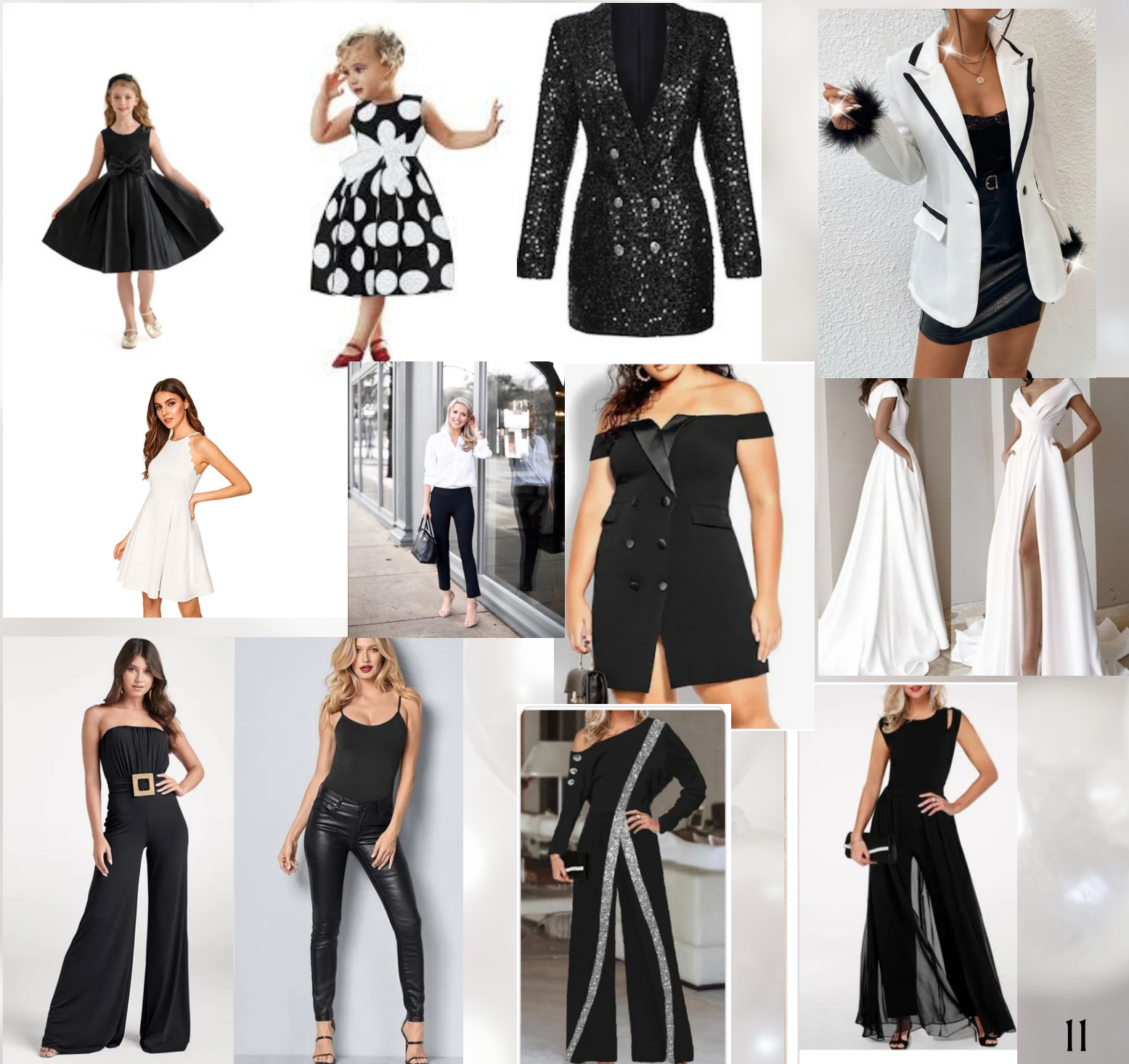

State Costume

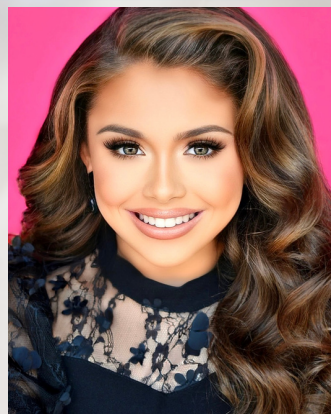
Contestant will model a state costume of her choice that can be handmade or purchased but should represent her home state. State Costume will take place during the pageant.

NOTE: Contestant **MUST** provide a short description of her costume and its meaning; will need to include your name, division, title, and the costume description. If writing, please be neat. **DESCRIPTION MUST BE TURNED IN AT REGISTRATION.** PROPS: Only small props can be used; no sharp metal objects, no glass, and must be able to carry or pull prop during presentation.



Cover Model

Contestant will submit 3 photos of choice, can be headshot or body shot and can be indoor or outdoor photos. Judging will take place with a panel of industry experts in modeling / fashion / print work.



Optional Community Service Award

The AUS Pageant believes that community involvement is important; we support our titleholder's vision for their communities. To show that support, we will award the AUS Community Service Award. This award is OPTIONAL; contestants are NOT required to register for this award and a platform is NOT required for the pageant. This award is to offer recognition to those taking part in community activities as a volunteer. To enter, complete the form located in the "forms tab" of the "contestant forum" on the website; you will ALSO submit a 1-page or less essay that shares your thoughts on being a volunteer. A separate judging panel will select the Community Service Award Winners for each division and this has NO bearing on the pageant outcome. There is NO FEE to enter the Optional Community Service Award.



Optional Banner Sales

Form and directions available in the “forms tab” of the “contestant forum” for the OPTIONAL advertising banners for contestants. Contestants are NOT required to purchase or sell ad banners. Ad banners are \$125 each and will be printed in color on individual vinyl banners and placed throughout the venue. Once the pageant is over, the delegate can take her banner with her as a keepsake (banners are typically 2'x3', sizes can vary). Ad banners are a great way to show support for your favorite contestant. Banners are sold on a First Come Basis and we will limit the TOTAL number of banners to 30, so secure your banners early. Banners must be submitted in JPEG, TIFF, AI, OR PNG format.

NOTE: Contestants that sell 2 banners will receive their Pageant Show Video Download free (\$35 value).



TRAVEL & SHUTTLE INFORMATION

Airport: Piedmont Triad International Airport

Airport is approximately 15 minutes to the pageant venue and hotels.

Airport Shuttle Service (Optional)

Contestants who are flying can choose to rent a car at the airport or utilize the Hotel's Airport Transfers to and from hotel and airport.

Car Rentals are available at the airport. Contestants can "buddy-up" and split the cost if they prefer to rent a car. To seek a buddy for transfers, you can post in the AUS Secret Contestant Group and / or private message each other. If your flight is delayed, there are NO additional charges, the transfer service will wait for your call. Uber and Lyft are also highly available in High Point.

Shuttle Between Hotel and Venue

For those flying and utilizing the above shuttle service, we will offer at no additional cost your transfers to and from the venue and hotel. To utilize this you MUST be flying and you MUST stay at The Marriott Springhill Suites.

Host Hotel Info

AUS has an Official Host Hotel Option: Delegates are NOT required to stay at the host hotel option.

2) Additional hotel options: Hilton Garden Inn Greensboro Airport; Holiday Inn High Point.

**The Marriott Springhill Suites is walking distance to food (Stock + Grain Food Hall with 11 dining options) and close to shopping. Those participating in points programs may use their points to book. The host hotel options are NOT required but we do encourage utilizing as they offer a discounted rate.

VRBO and Air BNB are available in High Point for those that prefer a more home style stay.

Security & Dressing Rooms

Access to Pageant and Activities

NO ONE other than staff of AUS and their authorized third-party service providers will be allowed backstage at the show. Jr. Miss contestants may have one female parent / guardian assist them in the dressing room up to ½ hour before the show; at that time, the parent / guardian must leave the dressing room and go to the theater.

Princess contestants may have one parent / guardian with them at all times. NOTE: Guardian MUST purchase show ticket in advance in order to receive their chaperone badge and will need to show proof of purchase at registration. Anyone without a pass found in dressing room area will be asked to leave or escorted out. There will be ample dressing room assistance.

Family / Friends traveling with contestant will have the option to attend the welcome dinner at their expense. This information will be posted closer to the pageant event.

Delegates dinner is included in their entry fee.

Dressing Room Space

Ample and multiple dressing room spaces will be provided for contestants. We must be considerate to all delegates and ensure each has adequate space to prepare and change. Important Dressing Room Rules for Pageant:

- 1) Each Delegate can have a maximum of TWO (2) garment bags for stage competition; this means multiple garments may be in one (1) bag. One Exception: State Costume can be in ONE separate bag if needed.
- 2) Each Delegate can ALSO have ONE (1) of the following: Rolling Train case OR Suitcase OR Duffle Bag OR Back Pack.
- 3) All items should be labeled with the delegate's name.

We will have assigned dressing areas for delegates; we will post dressing room move in times 1 week prior to the National Pageant. Once arrived for the pageant finale, ALL DELEGATES must remain in the dressing room areas or back stage at ALL TIMES.

Hair and Make-up

Hair and Make-Up Options:

Delegates are encouraged to do their own hair and make-up; it is NOT a requirement to have professional services to compete. If you are NOT using a hair and make-up stylist at the venue, you may arrive to the theater in full or partial make-up and hair.

The AUS National Pageant has three (3) hair and make-up options:

1. Do Your Own: Delegates will have ample time for both full make-up application and hair styling and / or touch-ups. Delegate will need to bring a power strip / extension cord if she has items that need to be plugged up, and a table top mirror if needed (long mirrors are provided). Jr. Miss division can have a female parent / guardian in the dressing room but they must leave 30 minutes before the show begins and they must have a chaperone pass to access the dressing room space. Princess contestants may have one parent / guardian in dressing room that is assisting with hair & make-up. The chaperone pass will be given once the chaperone shows ticket proof of purchase at registration as the chaperone pass is NOT a show ticket.
2. Vendor Option: The AUS Pageant will have Luxe Beauty - Allyson Jacobs as an on-site service provider; contestants using Luxe Beauty will NOT pay a space rental fee.
3. Contestants can bring their own stylist. IF a preferred stylist will on site at pageant venue for Pageant Finale, there is a \$50 PER CONTESTANT space rental fee. Stylist CAN take multiple contestants but the space rental fee is PER CONTESTANT. **If utilizing a personal HMU Stylist, you will need to complete the Optional HMU Form located in the "forms tab"; if contestant is using Luxe Beauty, you do not need to complete the form.

Little Miss and PreTeen Miss Hair and Make-Up Guidelines: Should be age appropriate. Make-up can be used that includes foundation, cheek color, mascara, lip color. Hair extensions can be used but should appear natural. NO flappers are to be used.

Ages 12 and Up Divisions Hair and Make-Up Guidelines: Can do full hair and make-up but should be appropriate for Jr Miss age division.

General Info

Welcome Party and Registration

July 23rd with time TBA. Attire is “Kentucky Derby” Theme with hat or fascinator of choice that can be handmade or purchased. Contestant dinner is included; guest are welcome at their expense. Details will be posted closer to the pageant event. Little Miss and PreTeen Miss divisions attendance is optional for Welcome Dinner.

Final Registration: Friday July 24, 2026 with time and location TBA.

Rehearsals

Delegates should wear a fashionable and comfortable outfit to registration and rehearsals along with their sash. Live social media feeds will be aired throughout the national event. AUS will provide light snacks and water; delegate should also pack a water and light snack in her bag as well.

Stage Design / Layout

The stage design and layout will be posted in the contestant forum and secret Facebook Group page.

Show Tickets

Tickets can be purchased directly thru High Point Theatre beginning June 15, 2026. Pricing for Finals night: \$40 for rows C thru G; \$35 for rows H thru O; \$30 for rows P thru U. Note: A dressing room chaperone pass is NOT a show ticket; guardian MUST purchase a show ticket. Only one Guardian allowed backstage for Tiny Miss, Little Miss, and Jr Miss.

State Crown & Sash at National Pageant

Delegates must bring their sash to the National Pageant; crown can be brought but will not be used on stage. Sashes will be used during opening number and private interview.

Post Crowning

There will be a mandatory Winners photoshoot and agreement signing Sunday morning July 26th and all Winners are required to attend; a list of wardrobe items needed are included on the “packing list” in this packet. Winners under the age of 18, must have a guardian / parent with them at the agreement signing. Location and time will be announced at the National Pageant.

General Info & Communication

Submission of Paperwork & Headshot:

All forms and headshot are due by July 2, 2026. All required paperwork is located in the Contestant Forum and is submitted using jot forms. Delegates will receive a password to the Jot Forms located on the website under the “contestant forum” once the minimum deposit is received.

Contract Break Fee

If a registered delegate HAS RECEIVED her crown and sash and chooses not to represent her title at the AUS National Pageant 30 days OR less prior to the pageant start date, she will be subject to a \$150.00 break of contract fee that will be payable to AUS Pageant. For LITTLE MISS AND PRETEEN DIVISIONS, there is NO contract break fee.

Competition Clause

As a State Titleholder, you CAN hold other pageant titles and you CAN continue competing. Upon becoming a National Titleholder, you will make appearances and return the following year to crown your successor.

Communication

Once we receive the minimum deposit, delegate will receive email notification with the forum password; contestant can then log into the America's United States contestant forum located on the website. You will also be invited to join the 2026 America's United States Secret Contestant Group on Facebook; there you can interact with the AUS Team and other contestants. All pageant info including schedules, host hotels, optional hair and make-up, tanning, welcome dinner info will be located in the forum and the secret contestant group on Facebook. The secret contestant group is a great way to get to know other contestants

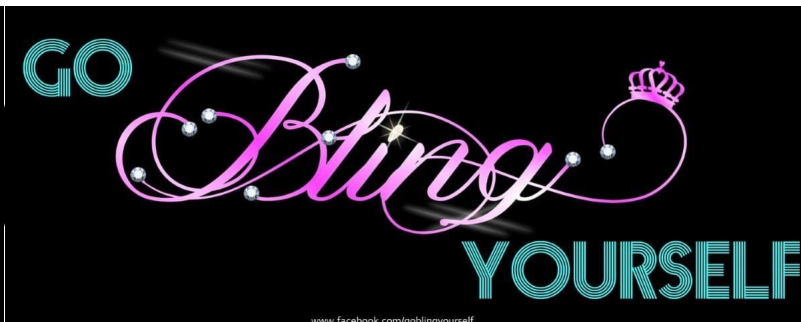

Frequently Asked Questions

- Can we bring snacks / drinks to rehearsals? Yes, you are encouraged to bring snacks and water / soda / beverage to rehearsals and outings.
- Do we need a jacket? We suggest having a lightweight jacket at all times for indoor events.
- What is the NC July weather? Hot! July in NC is very warm temperatures with the chance of afternoon thunderstorms so please make sure to pack an umbrella. We will be indoors the majority of the time.
- Can we have family/guest during rehearsals? No! Family and guest will need to leave after orientation meeting and cannot attend rehearsals (Princess Delegates can have one guardian remain at auditorium).
